PROJECT

We are looking for a new group of students who want to participate in a unique campaign to reduce waste with their own creation.

GUIDELINES

- 1. Submit a 500 word project proposal explaining how your idea will raise awareness about the amount of disposable waste we consume at the Blue Wall. Your proposal must have a clear and positive message about waste reduction.
- 2. Submit an image (if applicable).
- 3. Submit an itemized budget for up to \$500.
- 4. Identify a project lead who will be the personal contact for the assignment.
- 5. Dismantling and repurposing the current Trash Monster must be part of the proposal
- 6. Must occupy the same space as the Trash Monster with maximum allowable dimensions of 8 feet wide by 6 feet deep by 10 feet high.
- 7. Must be appropriate for a foodservice environment clean, nontoxic, and preferably hard washable surfaces (Trash Monster was not washable and probably would still be with us otherwise).
- 8. Keep safety in mind and make sure your project is durable and will not tip over.

WINNER SELECTION

Judges are members of SGA, Dining Services, Campus Center Facilities and EH&S. The winning concept will be announced 10/12/2017 and receive \$500 to use on building the project. Your project will stay at the Blue Wall for a minimum of one year and be credited to your group.
