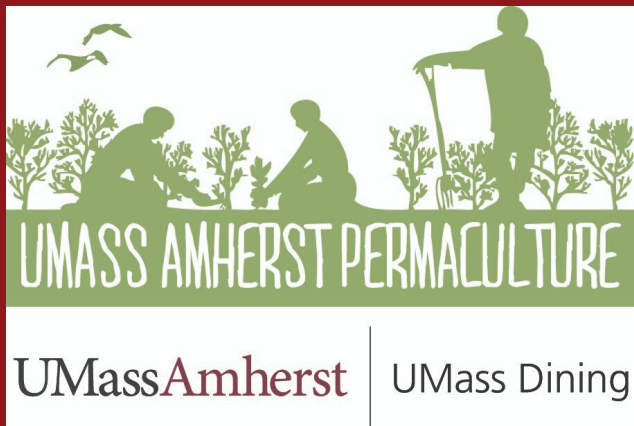
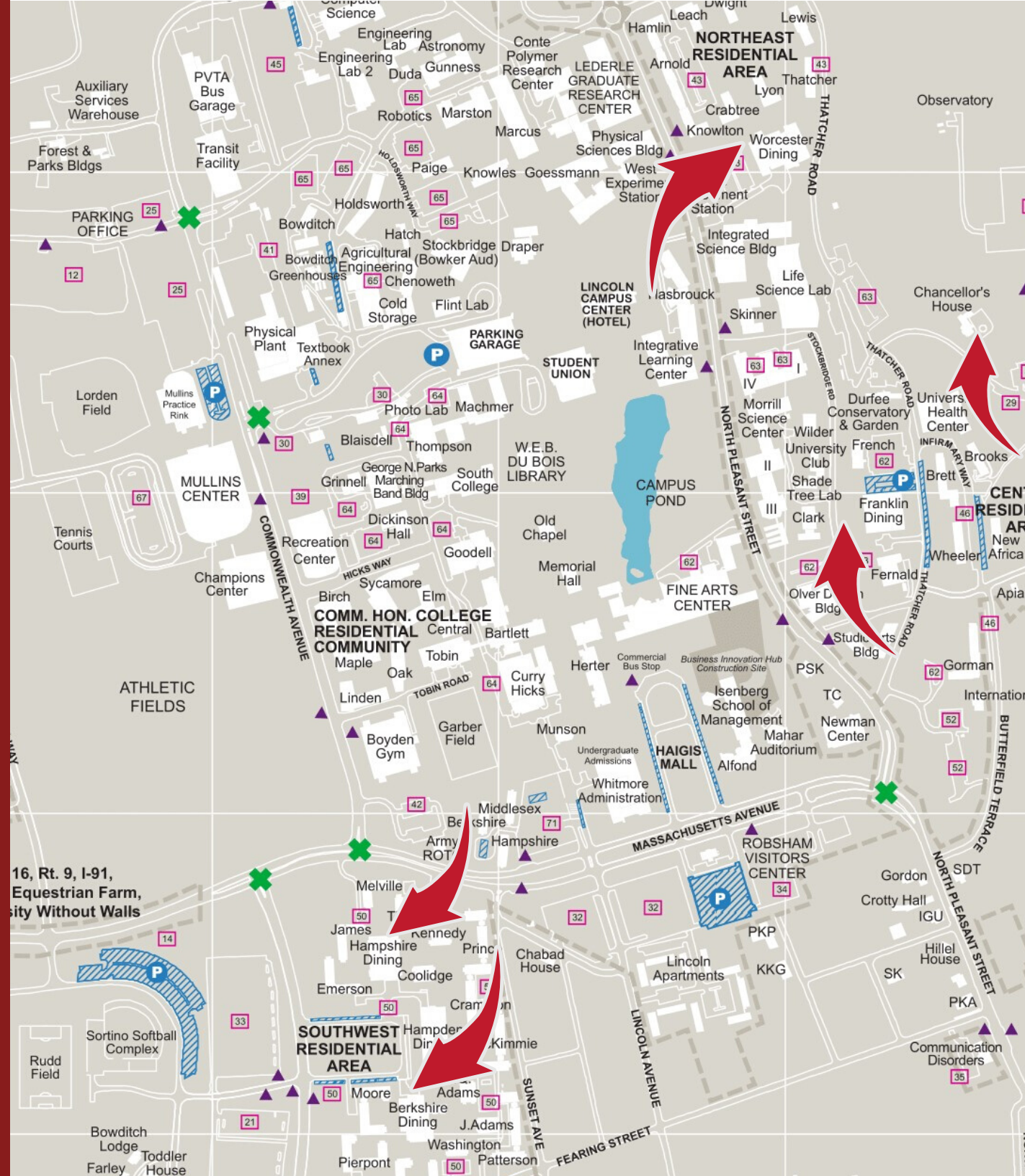
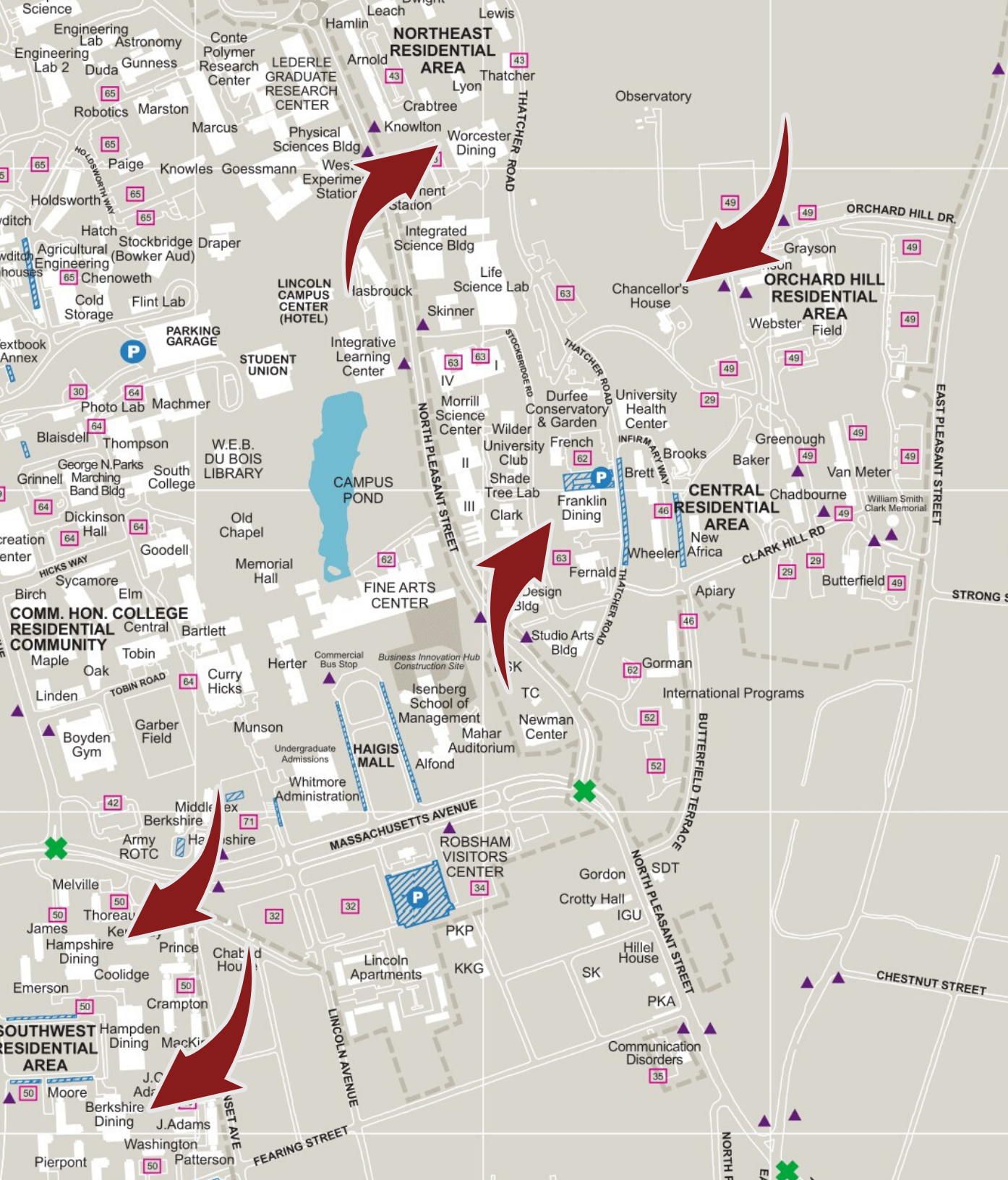


UMass Amherst Permaculture Gardens Map

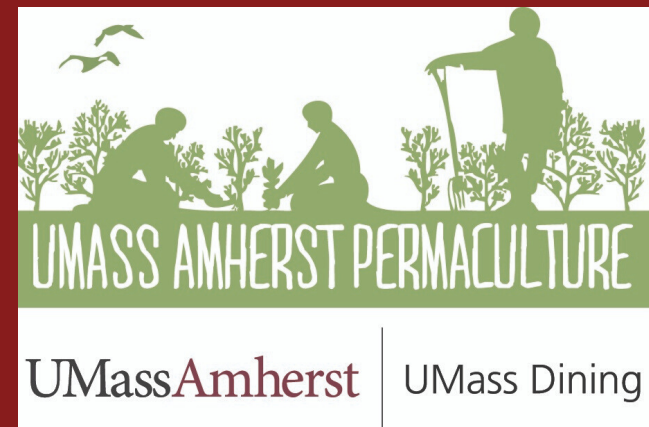

FRANKLIN GARDEN

Equal parts living classroom and production space, our award-winning ¼ acre flagship garden features over 100 different edible and medicinal plant species, beehives, edible mushrooms, a rainwater catchment system, and more.

HAMPSHIRE GARDEN

Just to the side of Hampshire you'll find an herb garden that was built in partnership with Eureka Inc., a local non-profit focusing on girls' empowerment. The garden features a wide variety of culinary and tea herbs.

BERKSHIRE GARDEN

Constructed in 2012, this garden represents the regenerative power of permaculture design. What was once a eroded construction site is now a 1/10 acre garden featuring a variety of off-beat edible plants including sea kale, sunchoke, chestnut, and elderberry.
