What operations will be open in the spring? UMass Dining will open all dining locations this spring—both

residential and retail dining. Additional location information is available at www.umassdining.com and the UMass Dining app.

- Will there be dine in service?
 - Dine in service will be offered in all Dining Commons as well as select retail locations, including the Blue Wall.
- If I do not feel comfortable eating in the dining commons, what are my options?



Students have several options this spring in addition to in person dining.

Berkshire, Franklin, and Worcester Dining Commons will have expanded Grab N'Go hours until 9pm—Monday to Friday. Students may enjoy a variety of packaged, to-go menu items for breakfast, lunch and dinner.

Expanded dining options—students with Residential dining plans (Unlimited 500,


- Unlimited 250, Unlimited DC and DC Basic) will receive 30 extra meal exchange swipes. These swipes are valid in all retail dining locations. The additional swipes provide expanded dining options for students, allowing them greater choice during peak dining times. (The 30 swipes are valid 1/24 to 2/13 and are in addition to the normal meal plan offerings.)
- Expanded retail menu items and meal combos will be offered to maximize YCMP meal swipes and Dining Dollars. For example, the Blue Wall will offer a specialty noodle bar from 5pm to 8pm Monday to Friday. Student favorites such as Hot Pot and Ramen will be featured in combo meals. (The combo meal includes the featured bowl, a sushi roll and a fountain beverage.)
- Expanded Grab N'Go locations will be utilized during peak times to de-densify and provide more options. The Newman Café will offer breakfast and lunch grab and go options (7:30 -2pm) as well as the Hampden (Chicken and Co) will open during dinner hours from 5pm to 8pm. Students can use their meal plans to take food to-go.

- In the Campus Center Auditorium, celebrated guest chefs will prepare Dining Commons' specialty meals featuring global cuisines—January 24th to February 11 Monday to Friday (Residential, YCMP and Dining Dollar swipes accepted)
